We are pleased to inform you that **Karnack Independent School District and G.W. Carver Elementary** will be implementing the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) under the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs for School Year **2017-2018**. In CEP schools, applications are no longer required.

Schools that participate in CEP provide healthy breakfasts and lunches each day at no charge for ALL students enrolled in that CEP school during the **2017-2018** School Year.

Karnack Independent School District and G.W. Carver Elementary will also offer healthy meals to all enrolled students as part of our participation in the U.S. Department of Agriculture's (USDA) Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) during the **2017-2018** School Year. The CACFP provides reimbursements for healthy meals served to students enrolled in afterschool child care programs. Students enrolled in Karnack ISD's ACE After School Program will be served dinner every evening of scheduled program days. The evening meal service will be held from **5:45-6:15 p.m.**

Karnack Independent School District and G.W. Carver Elementary will also offer a healthy Fresh Fruit or Vegetable Snack at 2:00 p.m. every day Monday through Friday throughout the **2017-2018** School Year. Contests and discussions about the Fresh Fruits and Vegetables will occur during the school year to aid in student awareness of the benefits of eating healthy meals and snacks. Students will receive awards their efforts in these contests and discussions.
